Review: myMonkeymoo stroller pad



It's 9:20 and both of my children are finally in bed and quiet. I don't hardly know what to do with myself. I guess it's the perfect time to introduce you to another product that I've been trying out: stroller pads by myMonkeymoo. I first saw these at a baby store that I just discovered here in Chicago, [Lazar's Juvenile Furniture](#). I was drawn in by the beautiful patterns and the plush fabric and couldn't wait to try them out.

We have the At the Zoo print which is shown in the picture. I love the colors and the fun pattern on the 100% cotton printed side, and the reverse is a deep blue plush fabric which matches our Bumblebee stroller perfectly. We've recently transitioned Ike out of the car seat into the stroller seat, and the plush side of the pad provides just a little extra cushioning for him in his new seat. I'm also looking forward to using the pad on our Bugaboo Cameleon. I posted before about how we went a little overboard in the pink department when The Princess was born. With the new sand sunshade we bought and the At the Zoo print on the seat, Ike can feel comfortable about not being made fun of when he rolls up to the park!

All ratings are on a four-star scale.

Functionality **** - The stroller pad has a very straight-forward installation. You simply pull the seatbelt and straps through the holes in the pad. This makes it easy to move from stroller to stroller as well. I love that it is machine-washable and even out of the drier it still looked like new.

Style **** - The stroller pads are a great way to personalize your stroller or a simple way to update the look. There are a variety of great fabrics to choose from as you can see from the picture below. I love the At the Zoo fabric that we have, and I just discovered the cute old school Dick and Jane pattern today.



Cost **1/2 - I'm always torn when it comes to this part of the review. As with any of the products that are designed to update the look of your stroller, the myMonkeymoo stroller pads are a little on the pricey side at \$69. They are not a necessity, but a luxury, and are priced accordingly. In this circumstance, I don't feel that they are really overpriced. You're getting a nice, cushy plush liner and a cool summery liner as well.

Overall Rating ***1/2 - I was excited to use the myMonkeymoo stroller pad, and I have not been disappointed. It was simple to install, easy to clean, and has transformed the look of my grimy Bugaboo Cameleon. It has also been a great cushion for Ike in the double stroller as well. I like the look and the ease of use. The price may be a little high, but you are getting two products in one. You can even complete the look with a matching stroller blanket for the winter months. Overall, a very well-made, functional and attractive product.
